# FEDICE Volunteers to Speak on Oct. 25

Two Oregon women who have worked with FEDICE in Ecuador this year will share their experiences next month. Bethany Waggoner and Kelsey Hertel will speak and share photos on the afternoon of Saturday, October 25 from 3-5 p.m. at First Christian Church in Eugene.

The gathering on Saturday, October 25 will feature presentations by both Bethany and Kelsey. Desserts and beverages will be served. Items from the famous market in Otavalo will be raffled off. Free will gifts will be accepted for the FEDICE project at Romerillos, which has about \$6000 remaining to be raised for its goal. The Romerillos project provides small loans to women for raising onions, sheep, cattle and guinea pigs through FEDICE.

FEDICE is the global mission partner for the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) in Oregon and SW Idaho. Based in Quito, Ecuador, FEDICE works with churches and communities among the indigenous people of northern Ecuador. The name FEDICE stands for Ecumenical Foundation for Integrated Training, Development and Education. FEDICE recently celebrated their 20th anniversary.


