# Matt's Minute

# "Cleanliness is next godliness." - John Wesley (circa 1791)

Contrary to popular opinion, this idiom did not come from your grandmother or the Bible. In his sermon preached to his congregation, John Wesley invoked the phrase "cleanliness is next to godliness" to entice his parishioners to be more motivated and more intentional about how they see themselves in the world. He used the phrase to contradict what he saw as the behavior of his congregation. In his words, their "slovenliness" was getting in their way of understanding the heart of God.

A contemporary synonym for slovenliness might be laziness, sloppiness or even carelessness. Cleanliness for Wesley, then, might have something to do with not being dirty, but more so referenced intentional and careful attention to one's actions and behavior. The wisdom, as I see it, in this phrase is about mindfulness, which I believe is much of the challenge of living in the 21st century world. The problem in our contemporary context is not slovenliness, but hyperactivity. There

are so many options and opportunities, so many things to do and so many people asking for your time, energy and money. We are asking for a small portion of your most precious commodity: your time.

This Saturday is our spring clean up day. We will be cleaning, raking, scrubbing, weeding, dusting, polishing and small maintenance projects around the church and at Disciples House. There will be plenty to do for every age and skill ability. We hope that you can carve out some space to give back to the church, a place that provides space for about 1500 people every week. Cleanup starts this Saturday at 9:00 a.m. and ends around 2:00 p.m. There will be inside and outside projects. Brunch will be served (Stone Soup) from 10 to 11. 
