Many people really liked the attention that our financial people are paying to our finances but there is still a disconnect between them and the rest of the congregation. Matt talked to Lee about putting someone that is not necessarily a finance oriented person on the cabinet to act as a liaison. We want to do more education

on what all our funds are. We would do these in small pieces so as to not overwhelm. Monica is going to come back and meet with people about Legacy Giving. We are going to try to resurrect the Worship Committee. It will be an ad hoc committee that Matt will work on getting together. It was great to have Monica here as an outside person affiliated with us and share her enthusiasm. We could probably have her do something else with us when she is here for the Legacy Giving information. We got the feeling that people really wanted to work on some of the stuff we talked about. We also felt like there was a pretty strong group that wanted to work on a Vision Statement. We felt like there is a group of people that really want to work on ideas and we could simply have a clipboard where people could write ideas down for things we would like to see happen as a program event or ministry and missions outreach.
